To Whom It May Concern:

The tax exempt status of The Lutheran High School Association of Greater Milwaukee was established by a letter from the IRS dated July 2, 1953, under the applicable provisions of the tax code then in effect.

A letter from the IRS dated November 3, 1958, affirms that status under section 501(c)(3) of the 1954 IRS Code. That status has remained and remains continuously in effect.

In 1995 the Board of Directors requested an update of that letter from the Internal Revenue Service. The IRS responded by informing the Association that it no longer issues individual determination letters to members of an organization that has been issued a group exemption and advised the Association to seek listing under the Group Exemption No. 1709 of the Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod.

On March 27, 1996, the Association formally requested verification of inclusion in the LCMS group exemption. As of that date, the Association is included under paragraph 7 of the Joint Letter Ruling of June 3, 1992, defining subordinate units to be included in the LCMS tax exemption, also dated June 3, 1992.

Gentlemen:

It is the opinion of this office, based upon the evidence presented, that you are exempt from Federal income tax under the provisions of section 101(6) of the Internal Revenue Code, as it is shown that you are organized and operated exclusively for religious and educational purposes.

Accordingly, you are not required to file income tax returns unless you change the character of your organization, the purposes for which you corporated, or your method of operation. Any such changes should be reported in character to the Director of Internal Revenue for your district in order that their effect upon your exampt status may be determined.

You are required, however, to file an information return, I we with the Director of Internal Revenue for your district so long as the file management in effect. This form may be obtained from the Director and Later aired to be filed on or before the fifteenth day of the fifth month following the class of your annual accounting period.

Contributions made to you are deductible by the denors in computing their taxable net income in the manner and to the extent provided by section 23(o) and (q)

Bequests, legacies, devises, or transfers, to or for your use are deductible in computing the value of the net estate of a decedent for estate tax purposes in the manner and to the extent provided by sections \$12(d) and \$51(a)(3) of the Code.

Gifts of property to you are deductible in computing net gifts for gift tax purposes in the manner and to the extent provided in section 1004(a)(2)(B) and 1004(b)(2) and

In the event you have not filed a waiver of examption certificate in accordance with the provisions of section 1426(1) of the Code, no liability is incurred by you for the taxes imposed under the Federal Insurance Contributions Act. Tax liability is not incurred by you under the Federal Unemployment Tax Act by virtue of the provisions of section 1607(c)(8) of such Act.

The 3rd paragraph of the July 2, 1953 ruling, concerning the filing of an annual information return on Form 390-A, is no longer applicable to you, since you are excepted from such requirement by section 6033(a)(2) and (4) of the 1954 Code.
